

## WHAT IS CLEP?

CLEP Testing (College Level Examination Program) offers 34 tests in a variety of subject areas. With no actual coursework surrounding the program, 68% of students with a passing score of at least 50 could earn 3 college credits at more than 2,900 US colleges and universities!

## WHAT IS AP?

The AP Program (Advanced Placement) is built on taking college-level classes that culminate in a high-stakes test. On a scale of 1–5, a passing score is typically a 3, which is accomplished by 65% of test-takers.

## WHY IS CLEP BETTER FOR ME?

While you may be able to pass the AP class, you still need to get a score of 3 (out of 5) on the AP exam to receive college credit! With CLEP, you simply need to pass the exam with a 50 (out of 80). Each CLEP test costs \$89.

## WHY A TEST CENTER AT FBCS?

Opening a CLEP Test Center at Fourth Baptist allows our students easy access to an untapped source of financial aid – reduced-cost college credits! Each successful CLEP exam could mean approximately \$1000 in cost savings to the student and family. Our test center has a \$35 administration fee in addition to the cost of the test.




