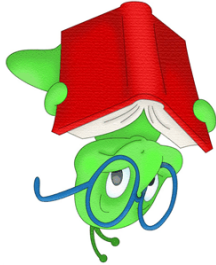


FBCS SUMMER READING CHALLENGE

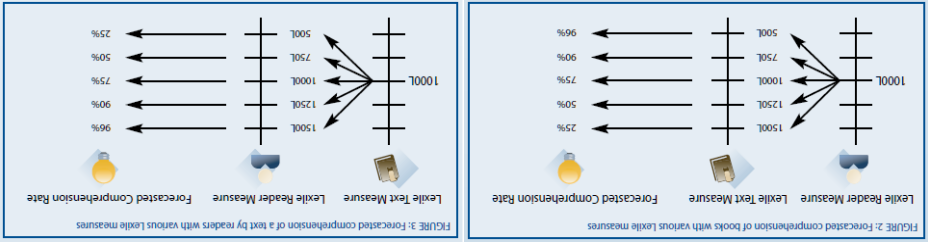
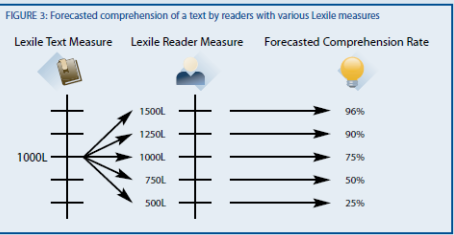
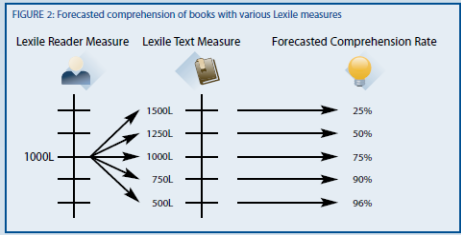
The Lexile Framework for Reading (a simple number followed by an “L” - 850L) is a scientific approach to measuring text difficulty and reading ability.

Grade Band	Current Lexile Band	“Stretch” Lexile Band
2–3	450L–725L	420L–820L
4–5	645L–845L	740L–1010L
6–8	860L–1010L	925L–1185L
9-10	960L–1115L	1050L–1335L
11–CCR	1070L–1220L	1185L–1385L

Lexile measures allow you to manage *reading comprehension*. Matching a reader's Lexile measure to a text with the same Lexile measure leads to an expected 75% comprehension rate. (see diagrams below). A student's Lexile range spans from 100L below to 50L above their Lexile score.

[Lexile.com](http://lexile.com), [Lexile.com/findabook](http://lexile.com/findabook) and <http://libguides.coastal.edu/juvenilebooks> are websites which enable you to check the Lexile measure for many texts, to help your student select reading materials at or above the current level. Reading material at a slightly higher Lexile level will help raise your student's comprehension. Selecting material in the “Stretch” Lexile Band will challenge your student to improve.
