JANUARY 20–23

OBJECTIVE: To build a team concept within our school and to teach leadership skills. We are teaching and encouraging our students to learn how to work together. In addition, all students get to participate in some fun activities!

BASKETBALL GAMES: We encourage attendance at our **HOME games** this week! Students and their guests earn 5 points for their team by attending *if they sign in* at the Admission Table. Students get in free to the JV/Varsity games this week! Regular admission fees apply for everyone else. **Alumni receive FREE ADMISSION to Friday's HOMECOMING GAMES!**

TEAMS: The students are divided into eight teams with our seniors & juniors being team captains & co-captains. Teams compete against each other for the highest final point total which will determine the team winner on Friday. The winning team name is added to the plaque in the office. The Team Captains have already chosen team names and are excited to get started!

EARNING POINTS: Students & Teams earn points by ...

- Winning activities at daily assemblies
- Participating in and winning daily dress-up contests
- Behavior: Teachers give points for especially good student behavior (initiative,) or take away points for bad behavior
- Attending Tuesday, Thursday and Friday home games and signing in at admission table for your team. Non-students can be recruited to sign in for teams at games.
- Friday judging for cheers, verses and posters

DOLLAR WARS: To encourage a spirit of giving, we have **DOLLAR WARS**. Please note that we have changed how **DOLLAR WARS** works. *We do not want coins of any kind!*

- Classes **earn** positive points for \$5 bills and above in their own buckets. (Place big bills in your own class's bucket!!!)
- Classes **lose** points for \$1 bills in their bucket. (place \$1 bills in other class buckets.)
- The class with the highest positive \$\$ total in their bucket at the end of the week will win an ice cream party (and bragging rights, of course.)
- All donations will go to **Metro Women's Center**, a local support facility for women who are facing crisis pregnancies.

SPIRIT WEEK DRESS UP DAY COSTUME GUIDELINES:

Dress up theme days are meant to be fun and creative. But please remember:

- **Modesty** is the standard for any costume If you are unsure about an item, please check with the school office.
- **Stick with your own gender:** Boys may not dress up as girls and girls may not dress as boys.
- **NO underwear** worn as outerwear. (even for Superman costumes)
- **Shorts & sleeveless/tank tops** for your costume may be worn if regular pants and T-shirt are worn underneath them.
- **Nice Blue Jeans and/or athletic pants/sweats may be worn every day this week**—this applies to everyone. (Jeans must meet jeans day guidelines in the Parent/Student Handbook.) You may change out of your costume after the judging and morning assembly if you wish. Photos will be taken of winners at the morning assemblies.
- ***NO FULL FACE PAINT*** for any costume, but you may use a small amount of face paint for costume accents. The seniors are offering colored hair spray and face paint on **FRIDAY** for \$2/each for face paint or hair spray 7:45am—8:25am in the Atrium.
- **Props/Accessories**—Remember that props and accessories as well as hairstyles enhance your overall costume!!

DAILY DRESS UP THEMES:

- **Tuesday—Pajama Day**—otherwise known as Get Up & Go Day—is back! Wear pajamas and slippers today and bring bedtime themed accessories!
- **Wednesday—Character Day**—dress as a favorite book or movie character. Accessories are important! (No toy guns, but toy swords are acceptable). Use good judgment for what characters are/are not appropriate. If you are unsure, please ask Pastor Jared.
- **Thursday—Be Bizarre Day**—Dress up in the strangest combination of clothing you can! Mix—but don't match!—your colors, patterns, styles and accessories into a crazy combination!
- **Friday—Warrior Spirit Day!** Wear your FBCS Warrior gear with Navy, White and Silver/Gray accessories! The more the better! Minimal face painting and colored hair spray is allowed today.
